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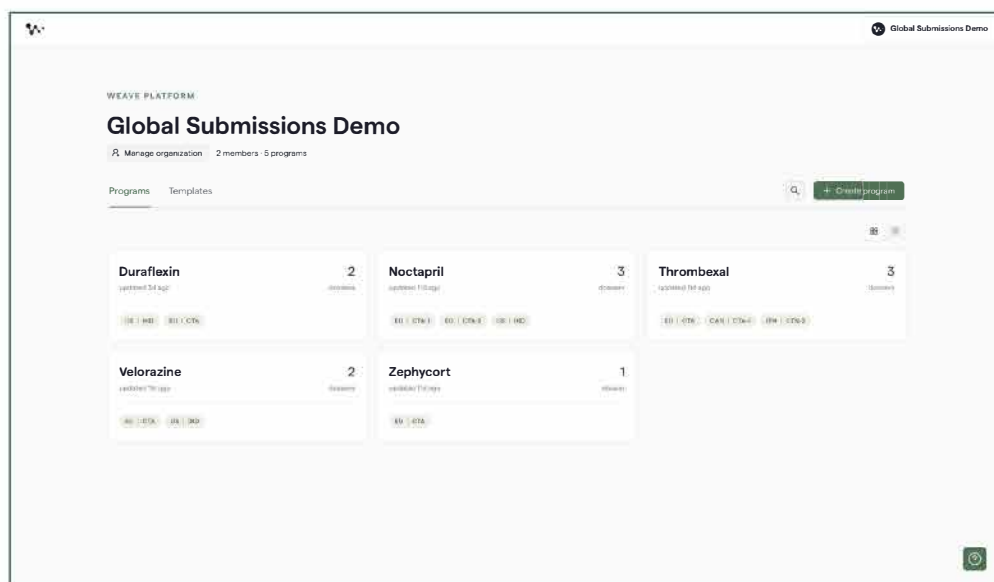
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Global Submissions

TOPLINE: BUILD EU CTAS, AND OTHER GLOBAL SUBMISSIONS, IN WEAVE

Use the same data in Weave to build submissions across the world.

Programs can now cover multiple submissions across multiple jurisdictions - each program can have multiple dossiers. All dossiers use the same source data in the program data room. Start from the same data, and build whatever submissions you need as your program evolves.



Dossier creation includes jurisdiction and application type metadata, clearly assigning which dossier is for what purpose and recommending the right starting templates. Keep track of your work globally, and adapt templates to your best practices.

New dossier

Create a new dossier for Duraflexin.

Each dossier is a distinct set of documents with its own lifecycle. Only create a new dossier when needed.

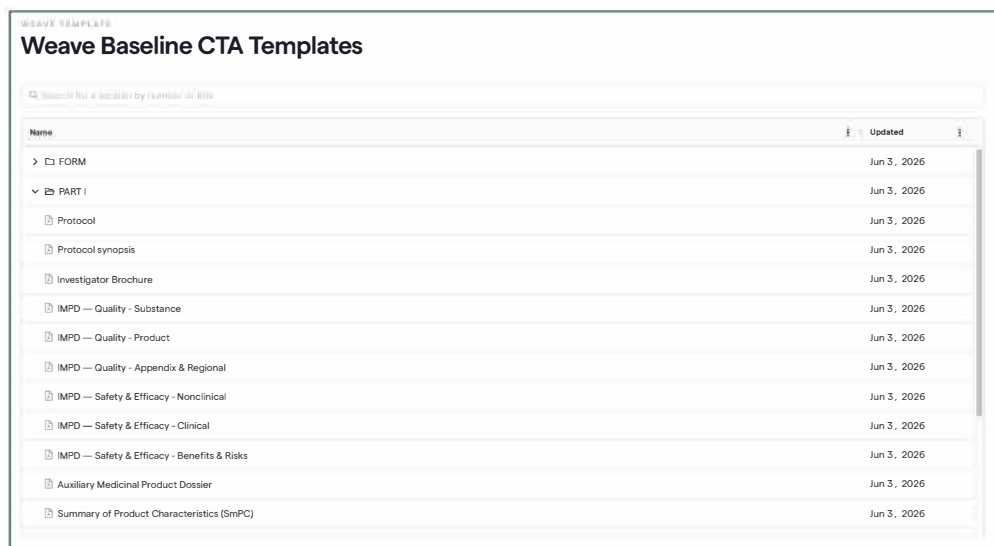

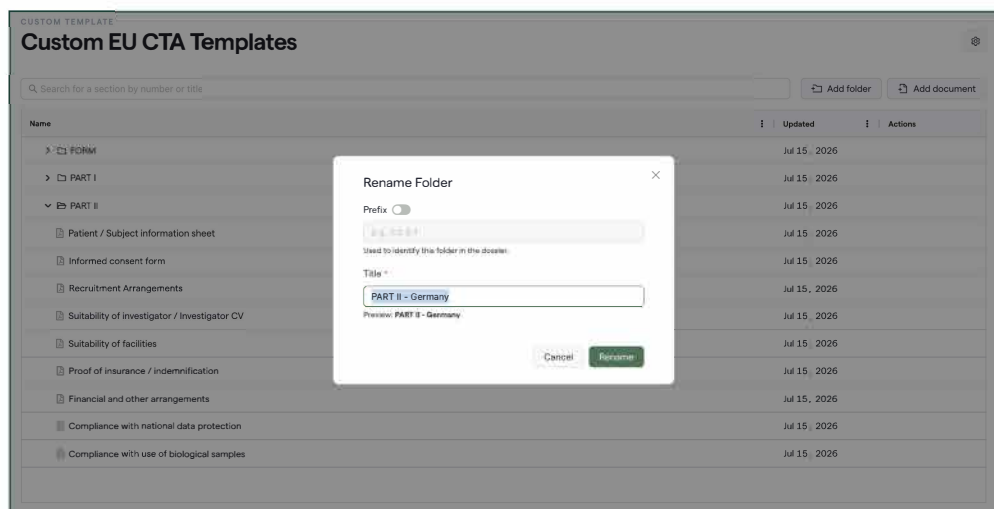

Weave now provides baseline templates for Clinical Trial Applications in the EU through CTIS, including Forms, Part 1, and Part 2. You can author EU submissions with AI, starting from Weave-provided templates.



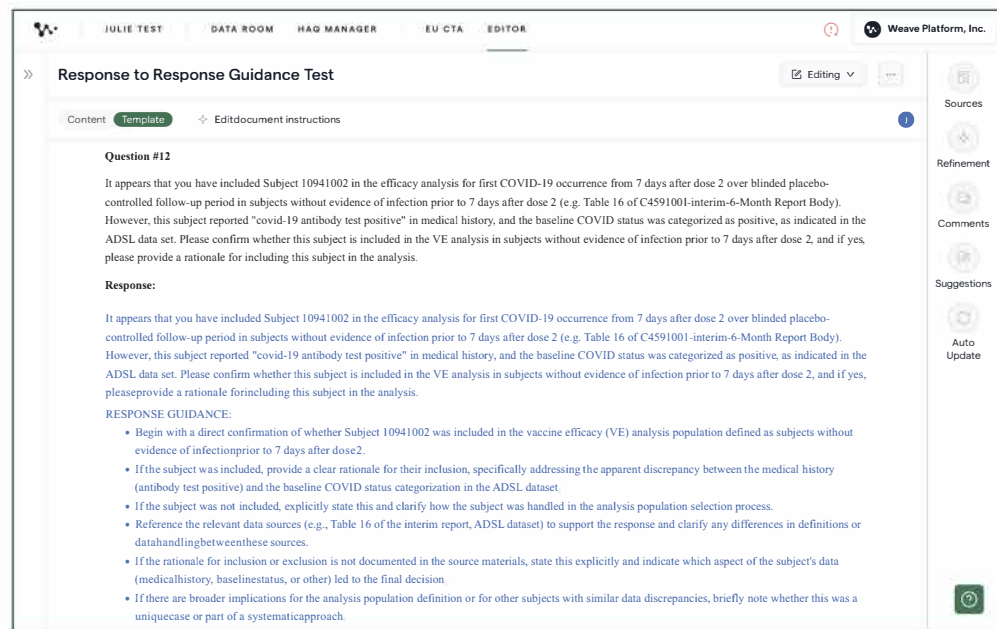
Organization-level templates now use the same dossier interface as submissions - see how your templates are structured and customize them by renaming, adding, moving, and deleting items.

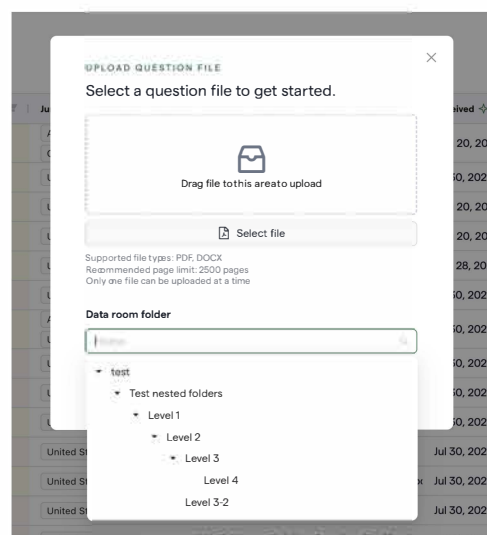
RESPONSE GUIDANCE ADDED TO RESPONSE TEMPLATES

Each response template now has Response Guidance bullet points! Besides stating the question verbatim, additional instructions have been added to tailor the response. Response Guidance is highly encouraged to be adjusted based on the strategy and intention of the response by the author(s).



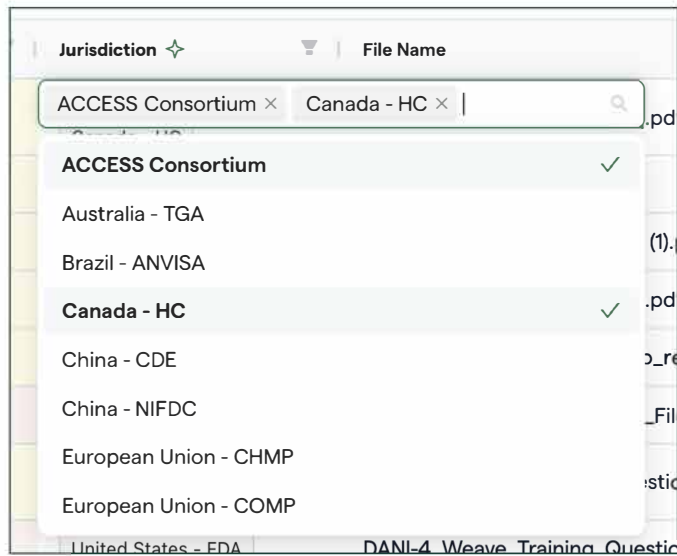
DATA ROOM FOLDER SELECTION ON UPLOAD

Optionally select a folder in the Data Room where the question file should be uploaded for better organization. Note that the home directory will be selected by default.



SELECT MULTIPLE JURISDICTIONS

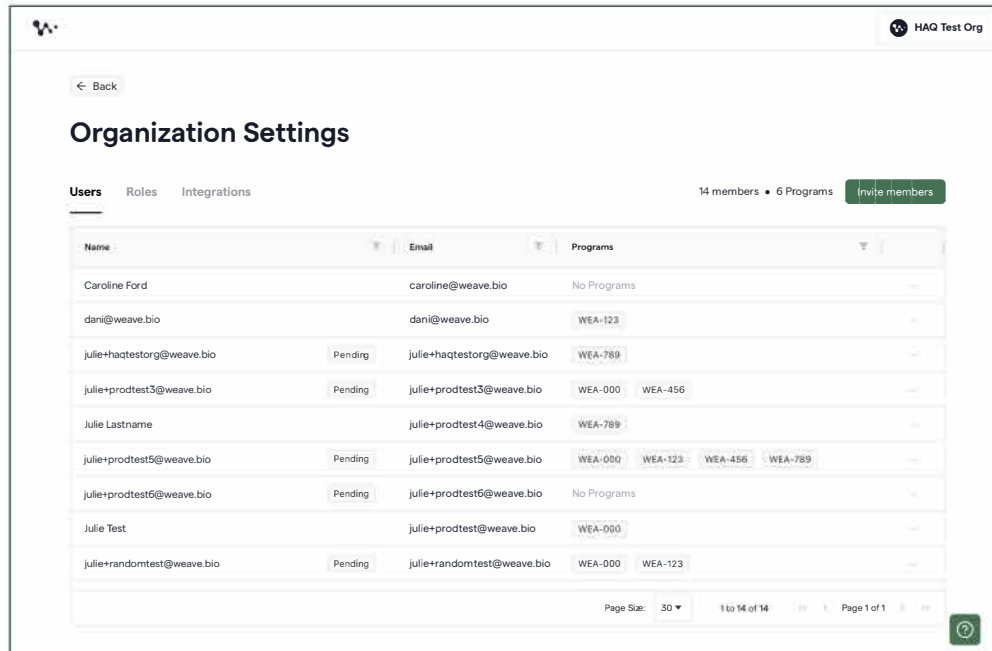
Select all applicable jurisdictions that may apply to a question file, especially in the ACCESS Consortium case. Note that only one jurisdiction will be auto-populated by Weave AI.

MANAGE ORGANIZATION

For customers with program-based licenses, Admin users can now directly manage all user invites and roles via the Organization Settings page. All user accounts can be seen in the Users tab table, along with their emails, program access, and if their invite is pending.

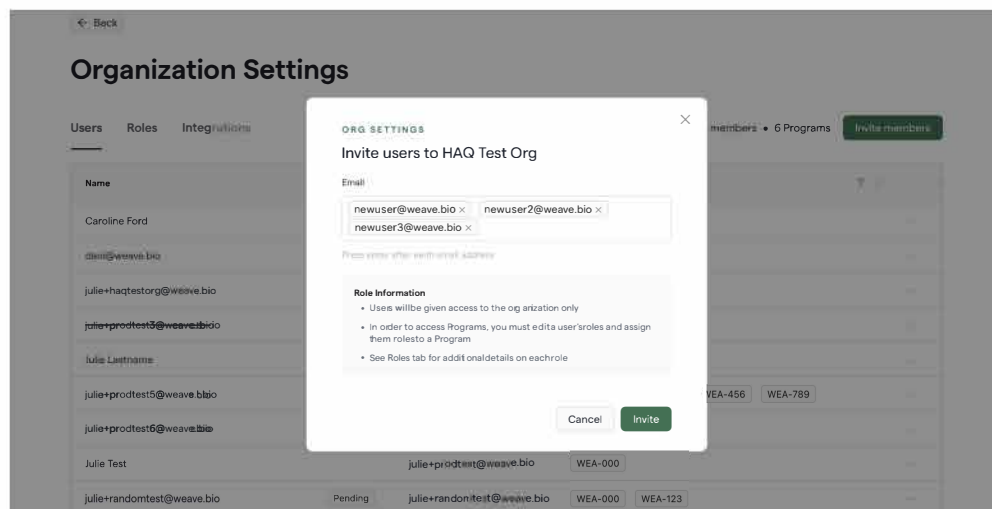

INVITE NEW USERS TO WEAWE

Enter new user emails to send them invitations to the organization. Note that all new users will only be given Base Access to the organization by default so they can login, but otherwise have no other access to programs.

EDIT ROLES FOR EACH USER

Update a user's roles in the "Edit roles" tab. First set roles at the organization level - the default is Base Access. Any roles set at the organization level will apply to all programs. Note that Admin users should have an "Admin" role at this level.
